Notice to Patients Regarding Insurance and Billing: *Preparing in advance for your medical bills*

Preferred Provider Networks or Insurance Plans:

Before scheduling services, please check our website www.morrishospital.org for a list of the current Networks and Insurance providers in which the hospital participates.

Please note: Providers (Physicians, Physician Assistants, Advanced Practice Nurses, etc.) may not participate in the same networks and insurance plans as the hospital and therefore you should also check with your insurance to assure your provider is in your insurance plan or network.

Contracted Services (Non-employed providers/services) and billing for those services:

Morris Hospital contracts with independent (non-employed) physician groups, for the services listed below,) to provide you the best care available.

These contracted services bill separately from the hospital. Below is information to assist in making you aware of other bills you may incur when you receive care or treatment at Morris Hospital & Healthcare Centers.

We have included their contact information for your convenience.

If you visit the Emergency Department:

You will receive a bill from the EPIC Emergency Physicians group (855-562-8626)

If you have Imaging Services: (X-ray, CT, MRI, Ultrasound, etc.) either as an outpatient or as part of the care during another type of visit (ex. Inpatient, Emergency Department, Immediate Care)

You will receive a bill from Grundy Radiologists (844-274-3658)

If you have a Surgery or a Procedure performed:

You may receive a bill from the physician performing the surgery/procedure.

You may receive a bill from a surgical first assistant provider EPIC surgical solutions (815-513-3654), and Chicagoland Surgical Assisting (630-393-3731).

You may receive a bill from the Anesthesia Consultants of Morris (517-787-6440)

You may receive a bill from a Neuromonitoring company for spinal surgical procedures: Nuvasive Clinical Services (866-702-1790) or Neuromonitoring Associates (NMA) (855-864-4322)

If you are an Inpatient or Observation patient:

You may receive a bill from any of the Independent or employed physicians that visit you.

If you require Durable Medical Equipment (ex. Crutches, Air Cast)
